Enclosures can range from 16" x 16" wall mount enclosures to free standing 15' x 6' x 9'. This applicant would be responsible for the following:

- Managing 10-20 assembly technicians that perform the mechanical assembly of enclosures and electronic equipment as well as electrical wiring of the system.
- Work with the Product Line Managers and manufacturing engineers to understand build schedules and priorities to ensure all projects are completed on time.
- Make sure all workers maintain good documentation for quality assurance.
- Manage the employee's work schedules, time-off requests, breaks, and deal with any disciplinary actions.
